

St Paul Bethany Congregation,

The ELCA publishes a new Model Constitution for Congregations every three years, and the current model is 2019. Our current constitution conforms with the ELCA model of 2016, so we're one edition behind. We are required to amend our constitution to conform with the current model, and as long as the only changes made in such an amendment are those of conformance, we use an abbreviated approval process requiring only one simple majority vote at any full congregation meeting. We will conduct this vote at our upcoming Annual Meeting on Sunday, January 22nd.

The St Paul Bethany office has forwarded electronic copies of the proposed changes via email. For those who are unable to access this electronic format, paper copies are available in the church office for review during normal office hours; 9:00 - 12:00 each weekday.


